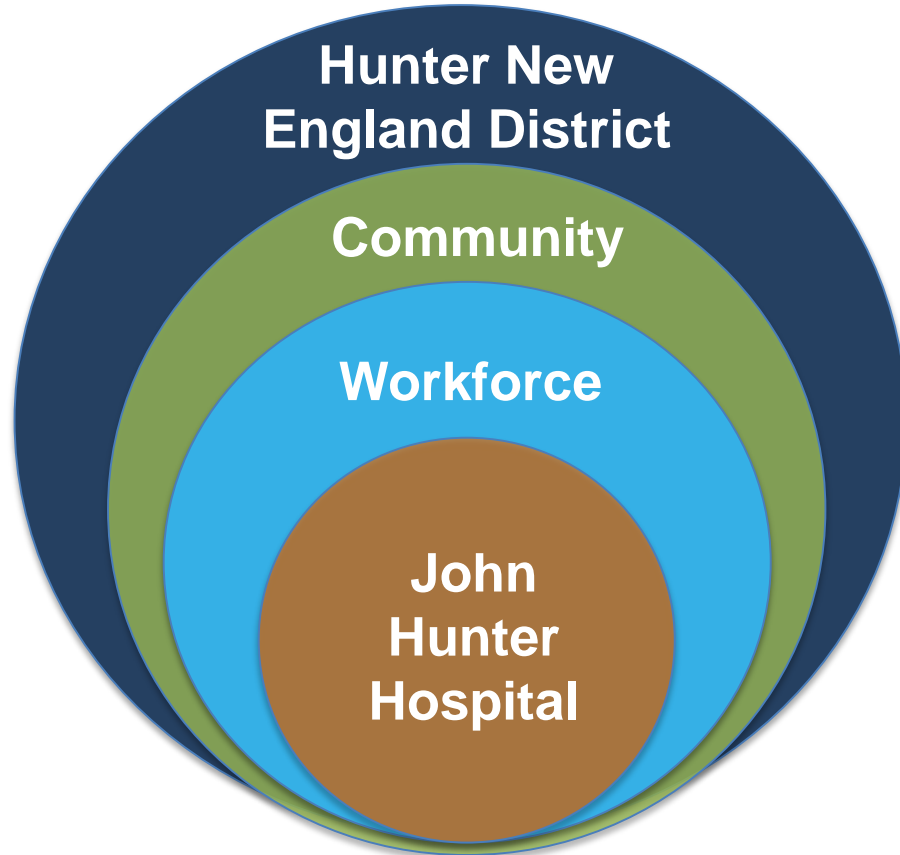

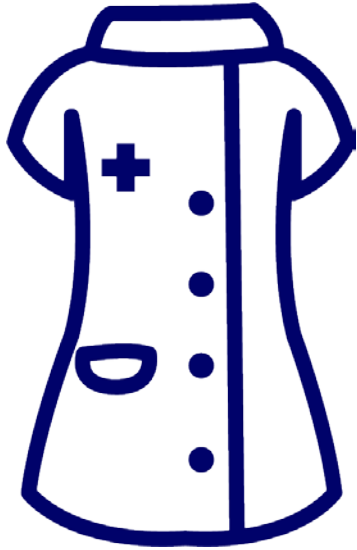

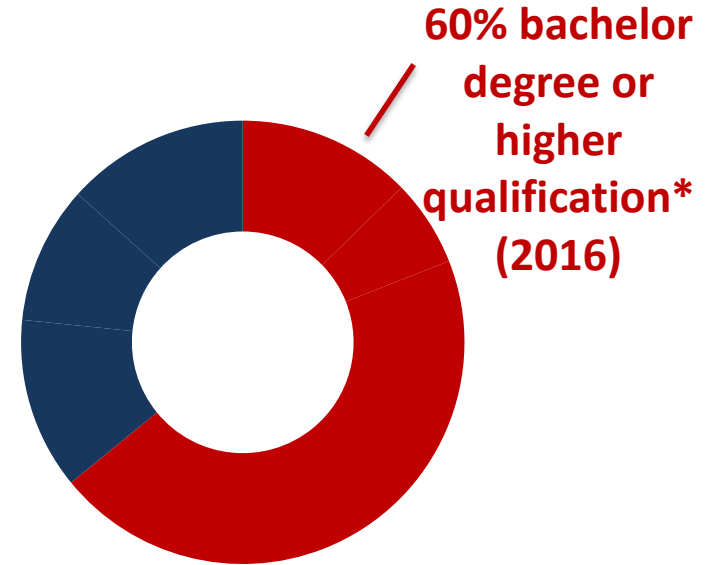
WHO WORKS AT THE JH HEALTH & INNOVATION PRECINCT?

REGION'S SINGLE LARGEST EMPLOYER

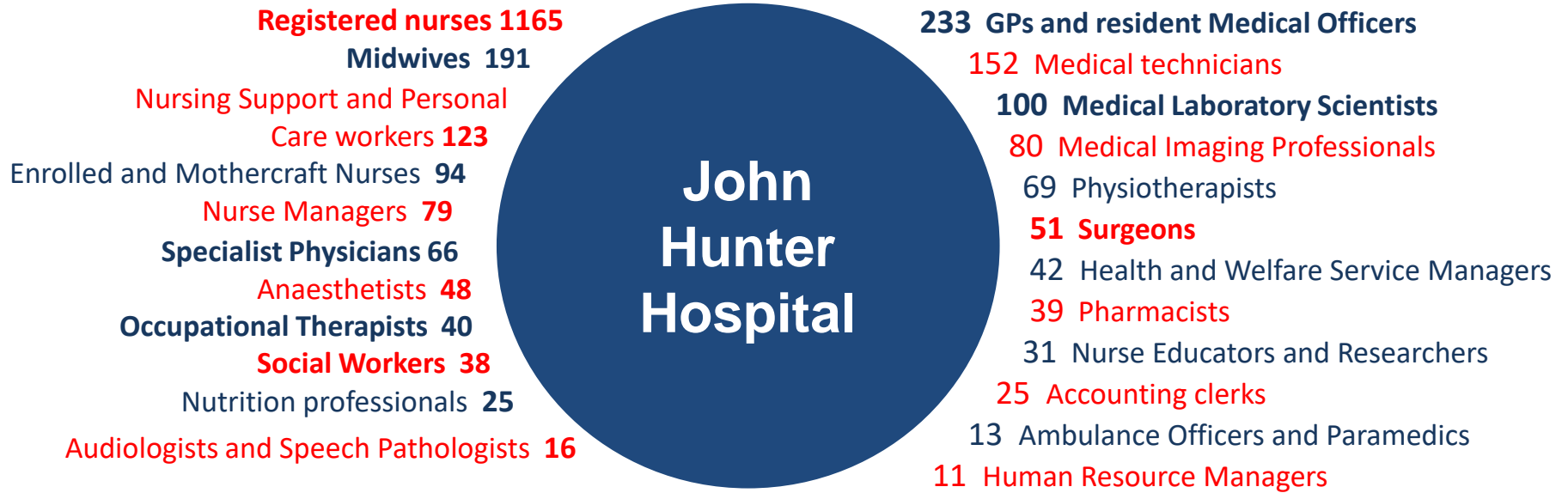

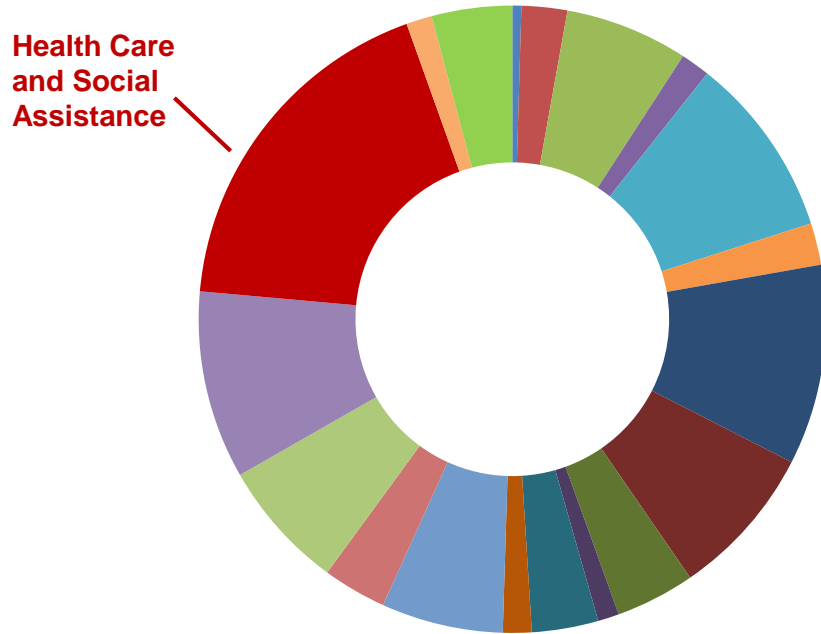

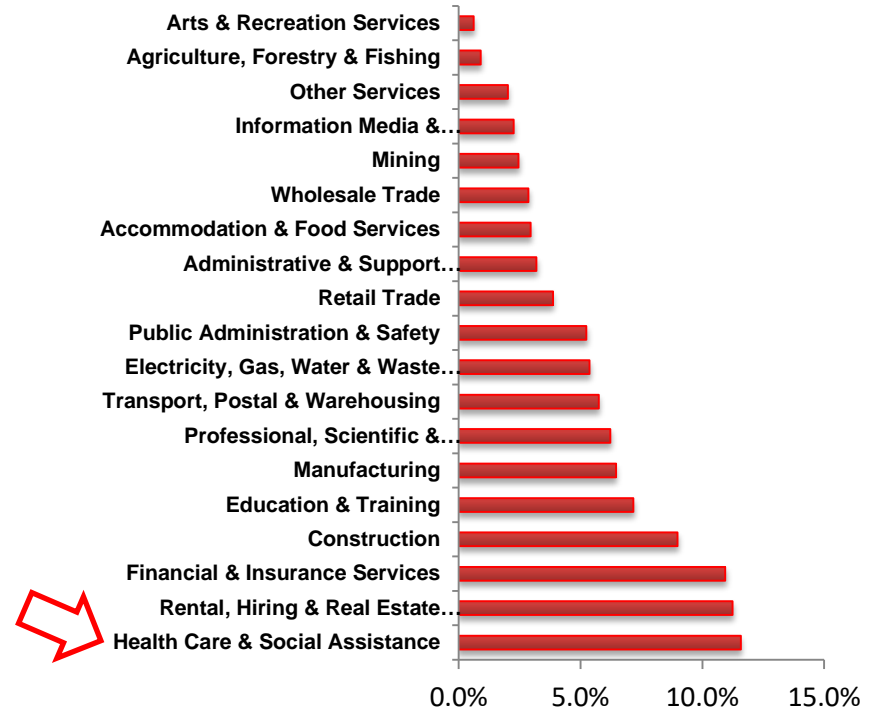
HEALTH: LOCAL ECONOMY MAINSTAY

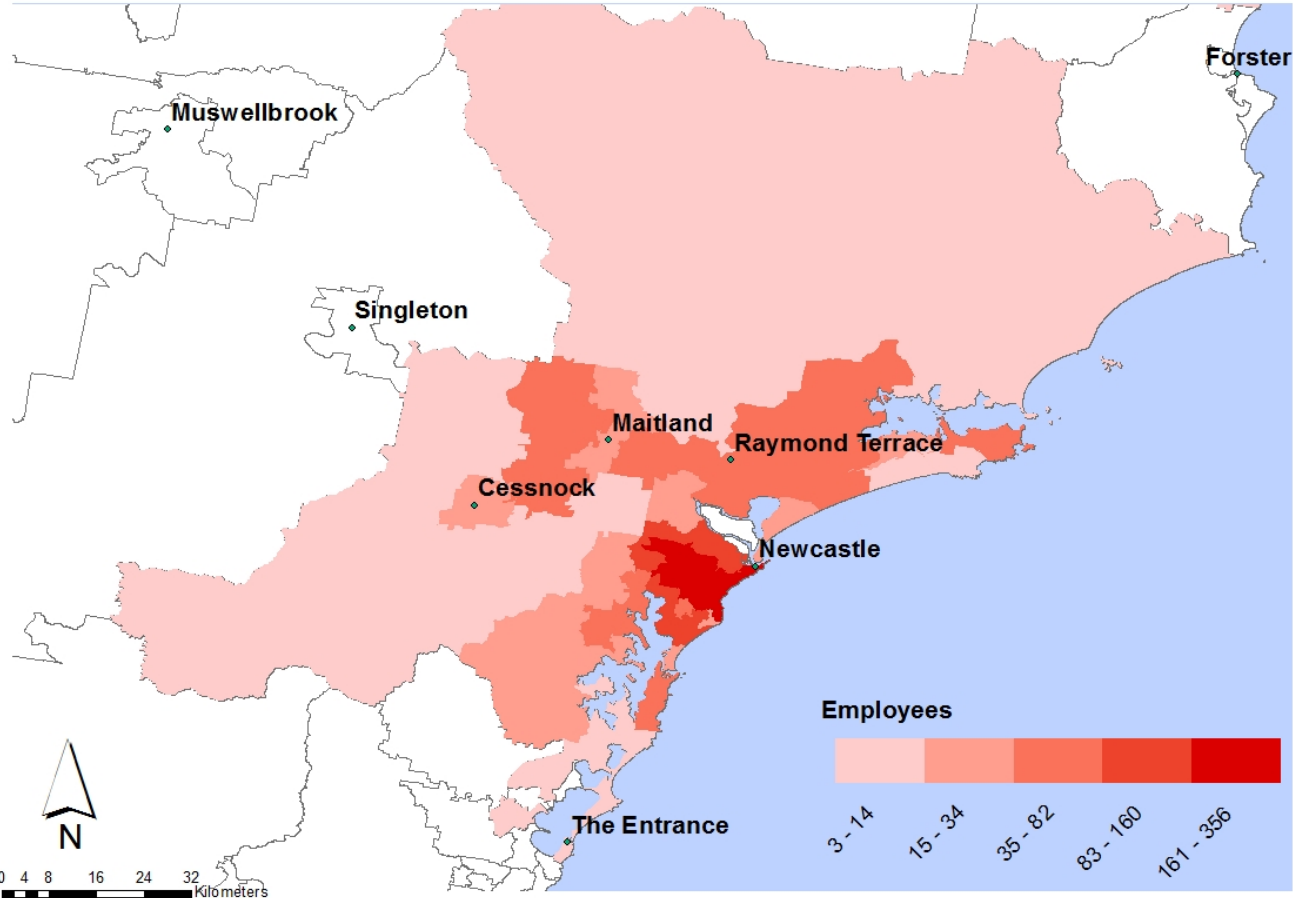

Greatest Value Add*



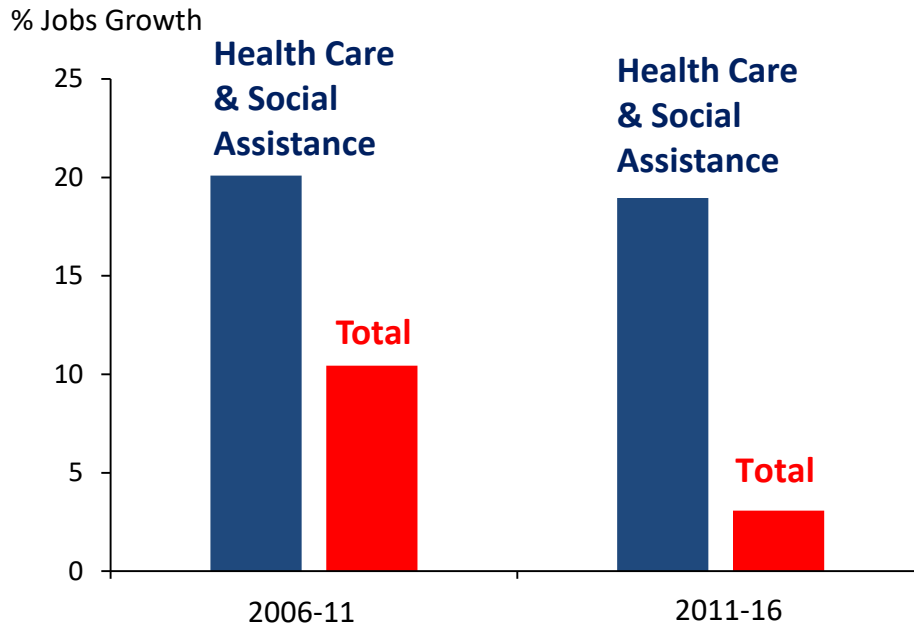

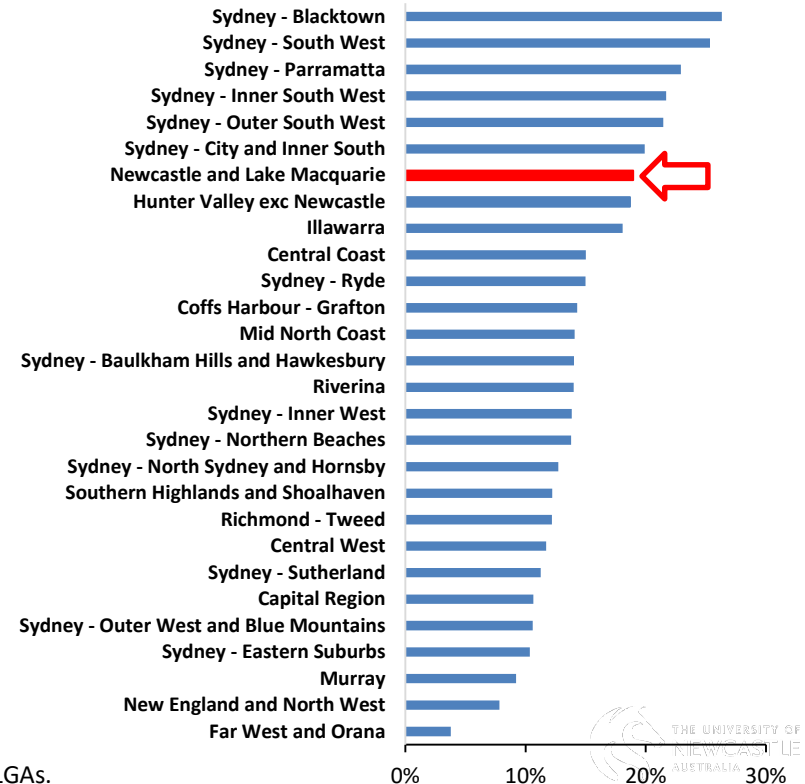

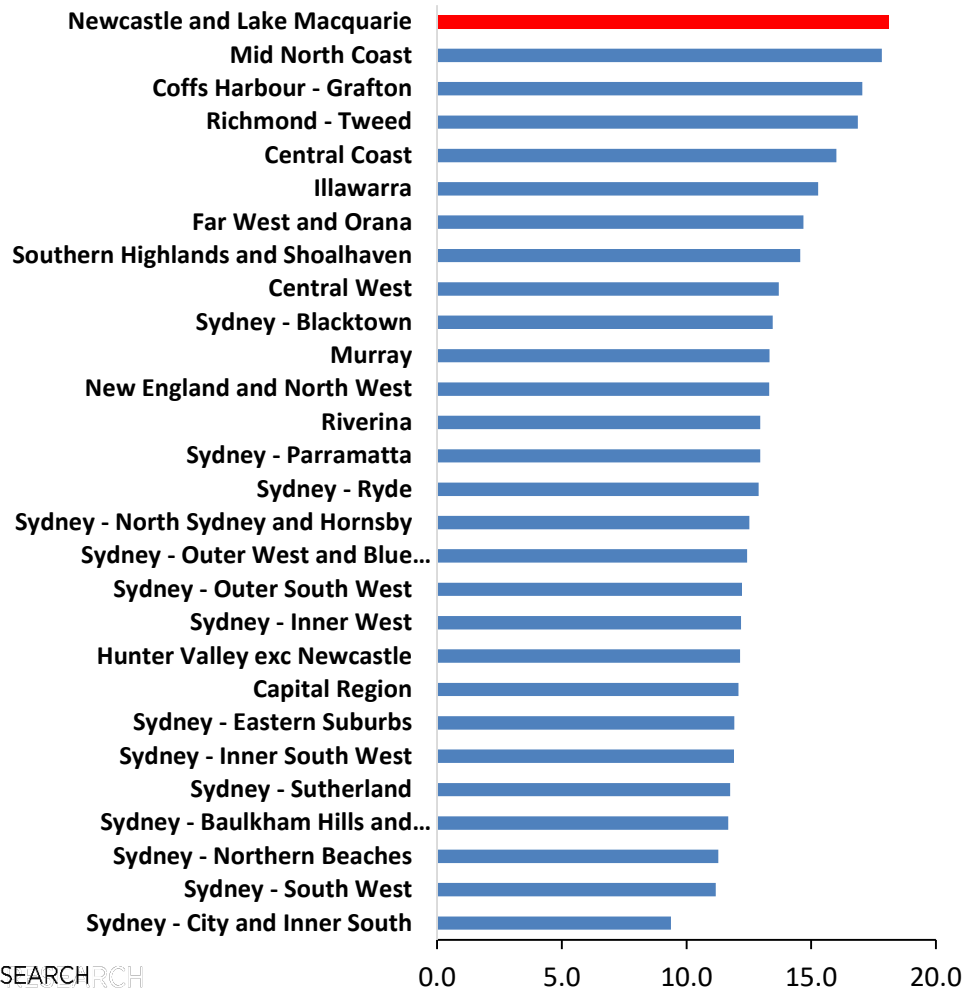
Sector adds approx. 1,000 jobs to Newcastle/Lake Mac economy every year...
